

THE CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATIONAL RECOGNITION

The International Association of Assessing Officers is proud to offer to its members the professional credential, the Certificate of Educational Recognition.

The certificate requires IAAO membership and course credits only. To receive the certificate, a member must have successfully completed IAAO Course 101, "Fundamentals of Real Property Appraisal," IAAO Course 102, "Income Approach to Valuation," the "Standards of Practice and Professional Ethics" workshop, and two additional elective five-day IAAO courses and must remit a \$25 processing fee with the application.

Completing the requirements for the Certificate of Educational Recognition puts you on the path to earning your IAAO professional designation. IAAO's Course 101 is a requirement for the CAE, AAS, CMS, PPS, and RES professional designations. Course 102 is a required course for the CAE, AAS, and RES professional designations. *Valid certification is contingent on continued membership in IAAO.*

The certificate is a permanent certificate. The certificate program creates a uniform international standard that can be used by jurisdictions to qualify candidates for professional positions. This credential may be carried from one jurisdiction, state, province, or nation to another. New recipients of the certificate will be recognized in IAAO's *Assessment Journal*.
